I wonder if the FUA logic is inserting cache-flush commands and perhaps the drive is rejecting those?

Jeff, we really ought to be including the failed ATA opcode in those error messages!!

If such a thing were available as a patch then I too would apply it and hopefully could provide useful feedback.
