Jens Axboe wrote:

Upstream 2.6.x certainly *does* care about suspend/resume! To me, this patch seems simple enough to be included. It's little more than splitting the register init out from the port\_stop/start functions and calling them on resume/suspend appropriately.

Upstream *\_libata\_* doesn't care much about suspend/resume. Officially, its a work in progress with major pieces -- your patch and ACPI -- still missing.

Further, good improvements covering some of the changes in Hannes' patch are already in #upstream.

Thus, it's more work than its worth to care about the patch as-is. It should be redone against #upstream, which is where all suspend/resume development is occurring.
