Register ext4 filesystem as ext3dev filesystem in kernel.

Why confuse users with the name "ext3dev"? If a filesystem lives in fs/blah/, it's registered as "blah" and can be mounted with "-t blah". Just register the filesystem as "ext4" and mark it "EXPERIMENTAL" in Kconfig.
