When this commit is reverted, I get sound, but playing a sound file results in about an 0.5 sec fragment being replayed over and over forever. If commit 7376d013fc6d3a45..., which is entitled "Simple patch to enable Message Signalled Interrupts for the HDA Intel audio controller" is reverted, the sound works fine.

MSI is now disabled by default on this driver, so I'm pretty sure you only have the first bug talking in terms of the most recent kernels.

You are correct. Only the "hda_codec-Add independent headphone volume control" needs to be reverted.
