Having some suspend problems on 2.6.20-rc2-git1 with Fedora Core 6. First of all the normal user interface for hibernate isn't working properly while it did in 2.6.19. When you select "Hibernate" it seems to stop X and go into console mode but somehow doesn't seem to actually start the process of suspending. I'm not sure at what point it is failing.

Secondly, if you try and suspend manually it claims there is no swap device available when there clearly is:

[root@localhost rob]# cat /proc/swaps
Filename Type Size Used
Priority
/dev/mapper/VolGroup00-LogVol01 partition 1048568 0 -1
[root@localhost rob]# echo disk > /sys/power/state
bash: echo: write error: No such device or address
```

Hm, at first sight it looks like something broke the suspend to swap partitions located on LVM. For now I have no idea what it was.

Have you tried any kernels between 2.6.19 and 2.6.20-rc2-git1?
