The following patch series adds LZO compression support to the kernel and exposes it in a variety of places (jffs2, crypto).

This is particularly useful for jffs2 where significant boot time speedups (~10%) and file read speed improvements (~40%) are seen when its used with only a slight drop in file compression ratio.

Providing the digits are accurate, this is very good stuff.
