Create a separate 9P client interface that can be used outside the VFS layer. In addition to VFS, the new interface can be used to export the authentication channel or from other interfaces.

And what exact users would that be? We have a huge dislike for putting abstractions in just for the abstractions sake, so if you want this merged you'd better present a highly useful client to that interface.

Also the non-filesystem interface code shouldn't live in fs/ but rather in net/9p/
