Don't look at me. This has been sitting in my tree for nearly two years as part of the reiser4 patchset. It may not even be needed any more. I guess Ingo went on a fishing expedition and liked the change.

yes, i picked it up from -mm (as can be seen from the SOB line), and i agreed with that change regardless of the reiser4 patchset. (which might never see the light of upstream acceptance)

there's nothing more annoying than incomplete and inconsistent APIs. I'm trying to fix them up everywhere i see, and this is one of those cases. Adrian still has not given any rationale about why he wants to see the export removed.
