WRAP systems have an additional LED. The power LED is normally lit after boot and doesn't serve any other purpose besides showing that the system is powered on. Nevertheless, its state is controllable and we can attach a trigger to it.

There is already a patch queued up to do something like this in the LED tree, can you check that does everything you need please?
