A simple way to detect it on the assembler level would be checking that the section is the same after #NO_APP as before #APP

Not as simple as the section stack would have to be traversed to check whether there are any differences. And in the end, either such a complete check or a simple one you have proposed may not be desirable, because I can imagine in some scenarios the change of a section in an asm may be deliberate. Let's not limit the tools.
