27 files changed, 255 insertions(+), 180 deletions(-)

Hmm. I get very different statistics:

27 files changed, 434 insertions(+), 359 deletions(-)

You seem to use "git diff -w" to ignore whitespace changes, which explains it, but please don't - it makes it harder to compare with expected results, and it hides some changes entirely.

I do agree that using '-w' is often useful, but especially for the purpose of letting people know what changed it kind of avoids the point by hiding many things.

Yes, I've been using "-b" recently:

```
git diff -b -M --stat linux..$RELEASE
```

and if I remove the "-b", we match:

27 files changed, 434 insertions(+), 359 deletions(-)

I have a vague memory of having a good reason to cut over to "-b" a while back and noting that in my pull request, but if you prefer no -b, no problem.
