hi all,

i've recently got rid of WU and moved to vsftpd. i was wondering is someone could help me with the following challenge:

```
user: media
/home/media
```

```
essentially i have this situation in /home/media/:
lrwxrwxrwx 1 media media 29 Sep 30 12:59 music ->
/mnt/uber/media/music/albums/
```

/mnt/uber is a 120gig USB attached device.

now if i run vsftpd without `chroot_local_user=YES`, then i can `cd music` when in media's home dir, and I essentially get `cd'd` to `/mnt/uber...`

but i can also branch out of anywhere that my media user can – which is not great! is there another approach i should be using to allow the media user to `cd` into that music symlink, but nowhere else? I've often seen other linking mechanisms on large ftp sites – maybe something like that?
