Hi.

I just installed RH9 and installed a basic server. I almost immediately downloaded and install apt and ran 'atp-get update sendmail'. It subsequently downloaded about 52 packages and installed them.

I then changed the /etc/mail/sendmail.mc file to allow connections from places other than localhost. I rebuilt sendmail.cf using m4 and then restarted sendmail and got the following error.
