To check all your interfaces:

```
# mii-tool
```

To change eth0 to full duplex for example:

```
# mii-tool eth0 -A 100baseTx-FD
```

In some situations you may have to use "-F" (force) rather than the "-A" (advertise) shown above. "man mii-tool" will give you a list of all the options and media types supported.
