I am in the process of setting up squirrelmail on a RedHat 9 server. I have the following installed.

squirrelmail-1.2.11-1

httpd-2.0.40-21.9

php-4.2.2-17.2

imap-2001a-18

netstat -l | grep imap shows that it is listening

```
tcp 0 0 *:imap:* LISTEN
```

The problem is that I cannot telnet to localhost (or from anywhere else) to port 143. Everything seems to be running but imap does the following when i attempt to connect.

```
Trying 127.0.0.1...
```

```
Connected to localhost.
```

```
Escape character is '^['.
```

```
Connection closed by foreign host.
```

I have googled and found other issues with imap, but cant pin this problem down. Any ideas?
