>running, all
>of the windows workstations get only a blank page after logging in to
>the microsoft hotmail service. By logging in from redhat workstations
>hotmail works as normal. We have no other problems in other sites,

>Emptying the squid cache does not help, but when the squid service is
>totally stopped we can log into hotmail also on the ms-windows
>workstations. No doubt that squid is the problem here.
