Hi Folks

When I click on the RHN icon to check for updates I get the up2date package on screen as normal but when I click on 'Launch up2date' I get the following:

This also happens if I open a new terminal window and try to run up2date manually.

Any ideas what could have gone wrong and how I fix it? At this point the machine is no longer checking for updates on RHN.
