> *Can we installed single copy of RHEL v3.0 in more than one server.Is
> it legal ?*

The subscription agreement states that you must have a valid subscription for *all* systems that are running Red Hat Enterprise Linux. You can subscribe none or all – you may not subscribe a subset of your systems.

> *Except it we downloaded RHEL v 4.0 from RHN through redhat's
> subscription model and using it in our produion servers(more than
> one).Is the subscription licence and EULA are diffrent for purchased
> copy and downloaded copy?*

The subscription agreement is the same whether you purchase a boxed set or download the ISOs.

> *According to EULA , we are restricted to redistribute or resell
> RHEL with Redhat trademarks.But unable to find license policies for
> multiple installation from single copy of RHEL.
> (http://www.redhat.com/licenses/rhel_rha_eula.html)*

According to the EULA (at least the US version), it states:

"If Customer wishes to increase the number of Installed System, then Customer will purchase from Red Hat additional Services for each additional Installed System."

This means that if you want to run multiple copies of RHEL, you must purchase a subscription for them.

Please note that I am not a lawyer and I don't work for Red Hat.
