How can I check what options were built into a specific rpm? For instance I would like to know if vsftpd was built with xinetd support. But even more than that I would like to know how to do this for all rpm's. I looked through the rpm man page but was unable to find anything that stood out, suggesting it could do this.

Get the source rpm, install it, and look at the .spec file.
