Hello,

When you boot in restore mode, try a fdisk /dev/hda. If fdisk succeed in accessing to the disk, then try a p to print partitions table.

q to quit fdisk,

mount the / on /mnt/sysimage, the the /boot on /mnt/sysimage/boot, etc.

Then, with a chroot /mnt/sysimage, you'll be in your file system.

If hda is not found by fdisk, verify the connections to power and motherboard (unplug – plug again). And check in the bios if your disk is detected. (you can do that 1st).

Then try to re-run grub-install in the chrooted environment.
