Trying to set up wireless networking with CentOS 4.4 on a (new Dell) laptop and have looked at <http://www.ces.clemson.edu/linux/fc2-ipw2200.shtml> and [http://www.centos.org/modules/newbb/viewtopic.php?topic\\_id=2532&forum=30](http://www.centos.org/modules/newbb/viewtopic.php?topic_id=2532&forum=30) regarding use of ipw2200, which is included in the kernel. The problem is that it doesn't appear to be actually installed/loaded because the Intel Corporation PRO/Wireless 2200BG driver doesn't appear in the drop-down list under Devices > New > Wireless Connection in system-config-network.  
Also `/sbin/lsmmod | grep ipw` doesn't produce anything – so I'm pretty baffled!  
Any suggestions please?
