is only running on 10 mbits and we need this machine in particular to run at 1000 mbits. I am currently not able to get on the Redhat gui interface but can at command line due to an additional issue. Could anyone tell me how I check the speed the network card is actually running at and let me know a way of getting it running on 1000 mbits.

You want to look at ethtool or mii-tool.

ethtool -s eth0 speed 1000 should force the card to gigabit... watch for errors and check /var/log/messages and dmesg output for any issues.

You might tweak with the duplex settings as well (see man ethtool)

Are you at the latest kernel/updates for your system? Perhaps newer drivers would address your problem.
