I had a similar driver issue with RHEL 5 with an Adaptec raid controller. It was resolved by selecting "linux noprobe" during the install and manually selecting the correct drivers. However, this did cause a problem with the network interestingly. To resolve that I downloaded the latest kernel from kernel.org, and recompiled it with all requisite drivers for the hardware in question and it fixed my issues.

Any reason why you're going with 2.1, and not a later version?
