I don't have enough space on the disk to keep all the mails so I need to change the mailboxes location of all user to another one.

I have additional disk space in another partition let us say /data

I tried to move /var/spool/imap/* To /data/imap

and then I create a symbolic link back to the original location

In -s /var/spool/imap /data/imap

but when I try to access to a mailbox I get "IOERROR: opening /var/spool/imap/user/test01/cy.....: No such file or directory"

So I tried another way

I edited /etc/imapd.conf and I set partition-default to /data/imap

partition-default: /data/imap

then I removed the symbolic link.

It works, anybody knows if this approach is correct
