> *I need to change the dpi of my screen, but I can't find out where to do it.*

dpi is a parameter of the X server, see "man Xserver". I don't know the "recommended" way but you may try to change e.g. the Xservers file. There are more instances so choose the right one:

`/etc/opt/kde3/share/config/kdm/Xservers` – I would start here

`/etc/X11/xdm/Xservers`
