I'm trying to configure a new web server box to run my works external web site.

The problem is that the machine has only got 64Mb ram and I can't find any compatible ram around the office. Its going to run as a Samba/Apache/etc server with no KDE/X.

So how can I install SuSE as it keeps on encountering an unknown error. Is there a way how I can format the disk and create some swap space before running the installer. Or is there another way???

I've tried booting the rescue system, but that will not run.
