I wanted to explore using "kmlndonkey" and I found out that there is almost zero documentation for it. It asks for a username and telnet password during configuration and I don't want to setup something that requires the use of telnet on my machine. Does this really require telnet or is it just an ascii protocol?

Does anyone know what are the normal holes (port/protocol) to punch in your firewall? What do you use as a server? Does it autodiscover peers?
