Hi all. Having fits dealing with those wonderful ATI drivers. I had installed 2.6 kernels and then later uninstalled and reinstalled the SuSE kernel with updates to 2.4.21-166-athlon version. I have run make cloneconfig, make dep, and complete and successful recompiles, yadda yadda...

Everytime now, when I try to install the fglrx V-3.7.0, following the instructions (actually couple of variations - but still essentially the same) it get the following message from "modprobe -vv fglrx":
