

[SLE] SuSE Mailibg-list stripping off MIME boundary of first part

Hello all:

I have encountered a very strange problem with SuSE's mailing-list with `pgp-mime` signed messages from Gnus. It seems like the mailing-list software is stripping the MIME boundary off the first part (text part) of the message thus leading to unreadable mail. For example, this is from the original message:

After it has been processed by the list software, it becomes:

Notice the missing "-----". Have anyone seen this problem before?
