Hello SuSE people,

Since my upgrade to 3.2.1 I am having problems with kooka. Appears that it is not working with the upgrade. Part of a package named kdeggraphics3-scan which is held back by apt. Following is message received from apt when trying to install kdeggraphics3-scan:

Since you only requested a single operation it is extremely likely that the package is simply not installable and a bug report against that package should be filed.

The following information may help to resolve the situation:

The following packages have unmet dependencies:

    kdeggraphics3-scan: Depends: ocrad but it is not installable

                          Depends: libexif.so.9 but it is not installable

E: Broken packages

Then I tried a dist-upgrade and the kdeggraphics3-scan package was again held back.
