But... now yast does not allow the resolution to be set. I can do it using the fglrxconfig routine i8n a sh, but not with yast. yast screws up the screen when started and forces a re-boot to straighten it out again.

3d does not work. fglrxinfo diplays an error that says ...
Xlib: connection tp ":0.0" refused by server.
