> > */etc/exports with the wildcards I used in 8.2 doesn't seem to work in*

> > *9.1. I get permission denied with '/tmp *(ro,root_squash,sync)'*

> *That should work, when you use the host name when you mount.*

It's what always worked before, but I can't figure a way to make it work on 9.1.

> > *or '/tmp*

> > *192.168.1.*(ro,root_squash,sync)',*

> *I'm pretty sure that has never worked (except, as the man page puts it, 'by*

> *accident')*

Never tried it before the above failed and I read on a page since closed about exports, howto or something, that did or seemed to suggest it.

> *try*

> */tmp 192.168.1.0/255.255.255.0(ro,root_squash,sync)*

Works for me. Thanks.
