I note that on SuSE 9, 9.1, 9.2 the OOo/ZIP file associations are felled. Out of the box, the *.sxw, *.sxc, *.sdw, etc., all have the ZIP icon and when I edit the file type I find that the OOo files all have the *.zip extension listed, rather than the extension that they actually are.

When I correct the OOo extension in the 'edit file type' area and supply the correct icon, all ZIP files replicate that change ...and vice versa when I operate on the ZIP file type and correct it. I am extremely weary of this problem!

There just has to be an answer to this... or is it a *major_oversight* on the part of KDE, SuSE or OOo (whoever is responsible)??
