> > *bytes. gmail/new and gmail/tmp are empty.*
>
> *But there are *other* folders that will *also* have mail, inbox, linux!*

Well, same story there too. Some files under /cur, but nothing under new and tmp. (I didn't have any new messages at the time of closing, nor any unsaved drafts, if that's what goes under tmp.)

> *Apparently, that's all that you recovered.*

I recovered 2 GB of data! I hardly think that this section alone might have been lost.
