Hello,

I sent an email yesterday to this list regarding a problem I am getting with a barcode scanner connected to my PC through a keyboard ps/2 connection and under SuSE 9.3. I said that when my computer had redhat 9 this barcode scanner worked fine.

Today I realized that (under SuSE) each time I scan with the scanner I get this kernel message on the logs:

... localhost kernel: input: AT Translated Set 2 keyboard on isa00060/serio0

Well in my previous emails I said that in order to track the problem I tested this barcode gun on several operating system and these were the results:

---

Operating System	did it work?
SuSE 9.3	no
Mandrake 10.0	no
Mandrake 10.1	no
RedHat 9	yes
Mandrake 9.2	yes
Windows XP SP2	yes

---

Since this, I think there was a change in the keyboard driver in the passing from 2.4 to 2.6.

So I would like to know if it is possible to configure, someway, SuSE 9.3 in order to use this barcode scanner just like when I had Redhat 9 installed?
