- > *down?*

- > *If the interface is configured with a static IP in YaST, then the dhcp*
- > *client won't start or /etc/sysconfig/network/ifcfg-eth-id-\* can be*
- > *manually changed from BOOTPROTO='dhcp' to ...*
- > *BOOTPROTO='static'*

I have reconfigured the interface to use DHCP. Now I want to configure the DHCP client not to bring the interface up and down.

How do I do this?

I have added DHCLIENT\_ADDITIONAL\_OPTIONS="-o" to the wireless interface ifcfg but with this entry I do not get any IP address.
