Is this peculiar to the sd? devices? I opened a shell and got this on my reiser file systems (and one vfat):

```
linux:/home/Mike # df -i
Filesystem Inodes IUsed IFree IUse% Mounted on
/dev/hdc2 0 0 0 - /
tmpfs 96988 2 96986 1% /dev/shm
/dev/hdc3 0 0 0 - /home
/dev/hdc4 0 0 0 - /mnt/Linux
/dev/hda1 0 0 0 - /mnt/ME
```

It shouldn't be device-dependent at all. I don't have reiser nor vfat, but my df -i display looks like this:
