The list generates a bounce message back to the list (in addition, hopefully, to the person who actually sends the note) when it should only send the bounce to the person who sends the "offending" email. Is that what's happening?

It's more likely that somebody has put a block on receiving mail from the list – possibly at a server level – but they haven't bothered to unsubscribe first. Therefore the list will automatically send mail to that address but it is getting bounced back in the from that we see. It could also be a server problem and not the original subscriber's fault. I think we need to be careful about laying blame before knowing the full facts.
