I've been using tightvnc on Mandrake for a long time, its very easy to use on that distro, click on the icon from the apps menus and enter the remote address and display number, then off it goes.

Seems to be a little different on suse

It's the same on SUSE.

KDE Lauch, System, Remote Access, Krdc

Enter the address like this:

`vnc://remote_computer_name_or_IP`

If the remote computer is a SUSE Linux that has "VNC Remote Administration", then use `vnc://remote_suse:1`

If it's Windows or Linux with x0rfbserver, just `vnc://remote`
