I managed to solve that problem and here is a procedure for anyone with similar troubles:

- ssh to a remote server as root
  - with yast install x11vnc
  - man x11vnc to learn how to use it
  - login as an user who is logged on KDE (su <username> )
  - x11vnc –display :0
  - see on which port x11vnc is listening (5900, 5901?)
  - on local machine run: vncviewer <server-address>::<port>
- example: vncviewer my.server.org::5901

Voila, you have again access to your server's screen.
