How soon will there be an openSUSE 10.2 RPM for OOO 2.2? I would like to stick to the OOO that was "created by Novell, Inc. based on OpenOffice.org". The latest release I have is Build 2.0.4.7.

I didn't see any listed enhancements for plot speed in the spreadsheet. Anyone else find it so very damned slow? We now use kst for plotting. Great program. But I miss the spreadsheet to see the data.
