I have 10.2 x64, with the latest azureus packages from packman. When it starts, it opens the main window and immediately closes.

In the log file I find:  
/usr/lib64/jvm/jre/bin/java: symbol lookup error:  
/usr/lib64/Azureus/libswt-gnome-gtk-3346.so: undefined symbol:  
gnome\_icon\_theme\_new

So, any idea what else I should install? What lib provides that symbol?

It comes from libgnomeui.

Thanks JR,  
I have this lib installed, but looks like it is not referenced in libswt-gnome-gtk-3346.so,  
i.e. at least ldd output does not show it.
