Two possibilities I can think of here

- 1) It's a password protected archive
- 2) It's permissions are set to root and so a lock symbol shows in the icon to denote this

if it's number 2, then he can press ALT F2 and type "gksudo nautilus" without the quotes and browse to the file at which point he now has permission to do what he wants with it, including changing permission and ownership of it by right clicking the file, choosing properties, then permissions, and going from there

However if it's a password protected file, it aint no good to him without the password
