With deleting they go TRASH directly and aren't visible anymore except in TRASH !!

With "deleted e-mails NOT hiding" they are still visible in the INbox and disturb me !!!

To get them thrown out of the INbox one more step is necessary to EMPTY the INbox !! ;-)

Well, once in a while it is helpful to get a (too fast and erroneously) deleted message visible again to undelete it and store it properly ! ;-)
