Plus, it really is badly behaved if it writes a "new" file – when it should know it's modifying an old file – and doesn't bother to inform the user that the file moved. That should be fairly simple to both fix and get attention for.

Gedit is able to detect changes to an open file – it brings up a warning.

It also detects if the file has been moved and presents the user with "do you want to save" dialog – though this can be confusing: the file edit flag isn't set, so it appears saved (this has caught me out a couple of times).
