> *1. I know my CD player on my Linux machine boots because*

> *that is how I've installed previous versions with*

> *CD's made at work ! I used some Veritas branded CD utility.*

>

> *2. I made my own CD with ISO image from RH Fedora site using*

> *Nero CD copier that created a CD ISO image (from Windows XP) ,*

> *at home and I can see what is on it, but it does not boot .*

>

You better download the whole *.iso file(s), at least the 1st cd image, from your distribution. Google for "fedora3 iso download". Try bittorrent for such a download, but forget it unless you have broadband.

To burn such a iso, choose "burn cd image" under "extras" in nero or similar settings in other programs.

You won't see the boot block when you open a iso with winrar or some other utilities.
