> *6. This should reboot your box and the BIOS changes should cause your box
> to seek the Floppy as the boot device !!*

> *If that works AND IF you correctly made a BOOTABLE floppy with Windows
> system files on it you will, after a few moments while the floppy detects
> your hardware, be at a C: prompt. If so change to an A: prompt by typing
> A: This will put you on the floppy drive where you simply type FDISK /
> MBR. Now you'll be asked to confirm that you really want to do this. Say
> yES. That will remove your old Master Boot Record.*

>

> *7. Now reboot and enter the BIOS as above and change your First Boot
> Device back to where it was, save change and reboot to your CD.*

>

> *Your exact instructions may vary as I stated, as all BIOS menus are not
> identical. However, this should get you there. Usually, your BIOS menu
> will have the directions on how to chane your settings at the bottom of
> the*

> *menu ! Follow its' directions as they will be correct for your BIOS !!*

>

> *Good luck and sorry to hear you didn't like SuSE 9.2 :~) Perhaps you
> might*

> *tell us why ?? Good luck anyway....*

By the way, if you don't know how to change BIOS settings, you 'probably' don't know how to create a Windows bootable floppy disk either!! Make absolutely sure you get that right or you'll get an error message upon

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attempting to boot to floppy...If so, come back and I'll tell you how !!
You CAN NOT simply copy files to the floppy !! You must do this in the
proper way or you will fail !! It must contain the Windows system files
necessary to boot your system !!! Be careful !!
