Ok, got a short one for ya; another 'first startup in spring'. The last year I owned the bike (73? 74?) I had the bike in the garage, on it's center stand (I *\*learned\** that lesson!) and knew it would take a few kicks to get it started.

The compression ratio on this bike was something near 12 to 1, so you didn't so much 'kick' start it — it was more like you stood up on the kick start and dropped with all your weight. By the third time, I was starting to get irritated, it usually only took one or two, and I could just see myself slipping off the kick start and landing on the jewels!

So, I took one last try. One hand on the handlebars, the other out to the side to help in my 'descent'. Big breath. Great anticipation. An 'all-my-weight' plunge to the bottom of the kick start arc. Didn't quite make it. I think the bike was getting tired of this, too, and decided to 'kick back'. I'm so *\*very\** glad I kept the garage doors open because I became a Flying Walenda at that point — with no net, just a whole lot of concrete driveway.

That was the most damage I did to my body with the bike. No broken bones but a whole lot of broken, bleeding skin. Lucky I didn't get 'concrete poisoning'! The next day, the bike started with the first kick. ;-) )
