For some odd reason, I can't get any ports to work with Azureus, Its NAT/Firewall tester always reads 'NAT Error' every tme I give it a port to test. I even tried putting my router in the DMZ and still got nada. Is there something I need to do with AppArmor to make this work or do I need to start playing with the network services in YaST now?

This is what I do:

In Azureus' PlugIns menu under UPnP check "Enable UPnP" and "Release mappings on closedown."

In your router setup options enable UPnP and any other option that states "Enable configuration changes through UPnP."

In YAST / Security and Users / Firewall / Allowed Services / Advanced add the TCP port you would like to use, I use 49194, and give it a name in the "IP Protocols" slot such as "Az".

This assumes your router supports UPnP, if your router does not then see if a firmware upgrade is available for your router.
