- > *fine, but when I try to recompile the kernel (upgrading to 2.4.22 or*
- > *2.60.test9) there's no way to get things working.*
- >
- > *The involved modules are usb-ohci, usb-storage, scsi_mod, sd_mod. The*
- > *host controller is recognized and the reader too, but no mapping to*
- > *scsi (/dev/sda) is done.*

Are all the relevant modules loaded according to lsmod? Post the output of "lsmod && dmesg | tail -30" after you've plugged the device in.

- > *But kernel and all modules are compiled with no errors, and everything*
- > *else is OK.*

There are a bunch of suboptions for the usb-storage module. Turn them all on except "USB Mass Storage Verbose Debug".
